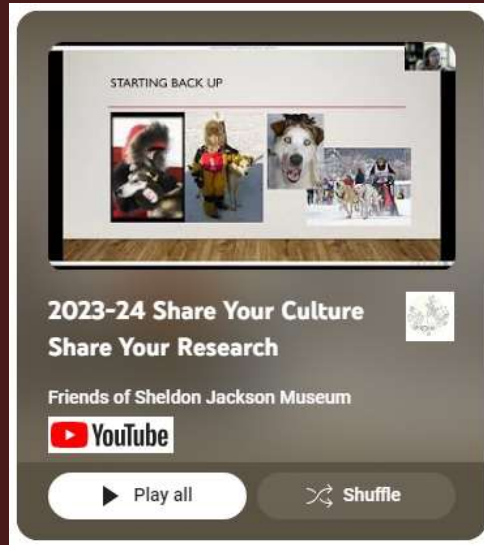

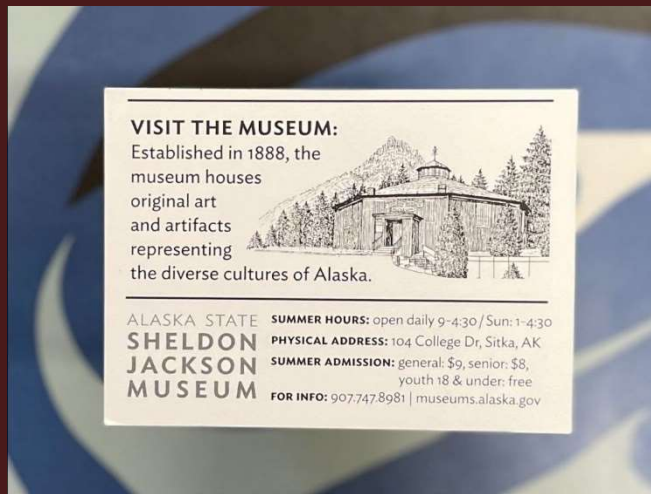

Summer Hours & Admission

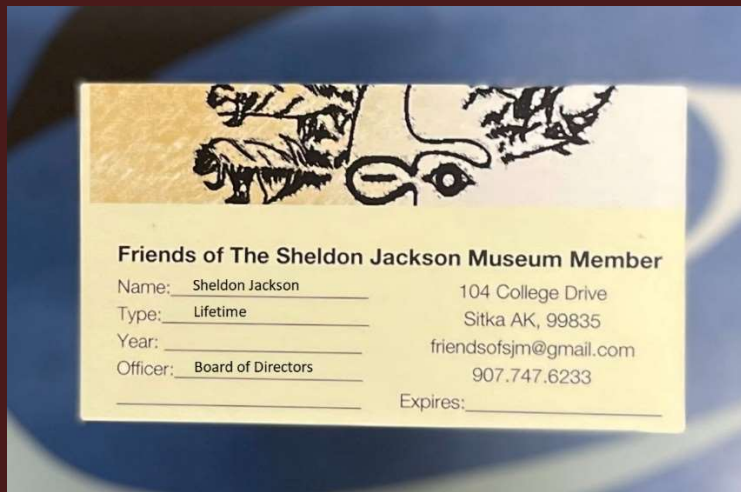
